

Course Title: Resident involvement

The involvement of residents is seen as critical to the effectiveness of housing associations, ensuring that their communities are places that they want to live. Involvement can also bring increased confidence and new skills to residents.

This one-day workshop focuses on ways to involve tenants more closely in the delivery of housing services and tools and techniques for measuring the impact of their involvement.

This workshop is designed to be highly interactive and practical. Participants will be asked to reflect on current practice within their own organisations and to use live case studies to develop personal action plans for improvement.
